DENSO PETROLATUM TAPE SYSTEM

A three-part system consisting of a primer, tape and outerwrap. An optional additional mastic is also available.

Denso Paste™

A soft petrolatum-based paste for the preparation of metal surfaces prior to the application of Densyl Tape.

Densyl™ Tape

A cold-applied, petrolatum-based tape used as an effective corrosion prevention solution on tie bars and post tension cables in any environment.

Denso Profiling Mastic

A cold-applied self-supporting mastic recommended for use on turnbuckles. This is an optional addition to provide a smooth contour prior to application of Densyl Tape.

Viscotaq PVC Outerwrap

Viscotaq PVC Outerwrap is a PVC backed tape coated on one side with a rubber resin, pressure sensitive adhesive. It is a tough durable outwerwrap that provides mechanical protection of the Densyl Tape.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1 - Cleaning and Priming

Clean the surface thoroughly by hand tool, removing all loose scale, rust, dirt, etc. per (SP1-2). Ensure that the tie bar is as dry as possible. Prime the cleaned area with Denso Paste by gloved hand or brush with a thin film as needed.

2 - Apply Densyl Tape

Next, spirally wrap the Densyl Tape with tension making sure a 55% overlap is achieved which ensures a double wrap at all areas. Smooth the tape surface to ensure overlaps are completely sealed.

3 - Apply Viscotaq PVC Outerwrap

Finally, spirally wrap the Viscotaq PVC Outerwrap with a 55% overlap. Ensure that there are no air pockets or voids and that all the tape edges are sealed down.
